Eige\_verksemd: Over the last 4 years I have created a fictional art collective, The Nonceptual Corporation. I have used this fictive identity as a conceptual structure to allow me to produce work across a variety of disciplines: painting, sculpture, installation, design and text. For the last 2 years, I have developed this project as part of my MA programme at KHiB. I will continue to work on this project post-college; although, I will experiment with other forms of artistic production and work on other projects, such as collaborations with other artists within Bergen and internationally; specifically, I am interested in the creation of printed art books. I contributed to 'Now' an image and text publication, with colleagues from Norway, Sweden and Lithuania. I also designed and wrote all the texts for my own publication 'Nonceptual Corporation Paintings 01-65' as part of final MA exhibition at the Bergen Kunsthall in April of this year. Planar\_for\_stipendet: I plan to use the funding to establish my artistic practice following the completion of my masters degree. I will use the money for research purposes and to cover expenses such as studio rent, art materials and printing costs. In the immediate future, I am interested in printing a second edition of my book; updating it with additional documentation from my MA exhibition.
