(Script and Situation)


Image of a staged situation from a script and adapted to the space focussing on prometheanism and how one might be able to organize oneself whilst working. Copies of the script lie in the space also. *Mise-en-scène* from front of the script:


A student-run gallery affiliated with the local art academy is being used by the landlord of the building over Summer as a space to aid the running of his small hostel next door.

The spectacle-making window on one side of the space showcases the recalibrating of its indistinct vacancy by the positioning of furnishings delineating some kind of activity. Further, seemingly ad hoc additions include a statuesque sofa, an unplugged television, and a number of varyingly-cheap wheeled units on one of which stands a Jerusalem Cherry plant. There are a few spotlights aimed at an area on the floor where something has been moved and the dull, distant tolling of what sounds like aberrant cocktail-bar piano jazz.

PERSON 1 occupying the space adjourns further work on the selfmotivation bullet-points they were staring at, appending the papers near some post-it notes on one of the walls the work area nears. The time is 12:30. They decide to take their lunch break. Just as they do so, someone enters into the space from the street.

Autonomous Work (2013)

(Performance/Sculpture)

Taking place in Landmark, Bergen Kunsthall, Norway, *Autonomous Work* involved the building of a small stage in the Landmark venue space before the ceremonial speeches of the graduate exhibition opening were made. The stage was not used for the ceremonial speeches. Set up on the stage was a microphone on a stand with its own mixer and two loudspeakers. Having been built whilst visitors were in the surrounding area, the stage stood until midevening, upon which it was disassembled and cleared away. The performance/sculpture was not explicitly announced.





<u>'New' 'Work' (Norway) (2012-13)</u>


(Performance-Installation)

Re-articulation of *'New' 'Work'* using a smaller isolated space in a group exhibition. Participants were paid according to a 120 Norwegian Kroner (approx. \in 15) hourly rate. A maximum of eight people at any one time were allowed to be in the space.

Part of Huddersfield Contemporary Music Festival 2012.


A person on a desk in the entrance room assisted people in filling out timecards before their entrance into the main space, informing them that they would fill it out again when they coming out and be paid the amount of time they spend within the main space according to the U.K minimum wage (\pounds 6.19 at the time). A maximum of eight people at any one time were allowed to be in the space. [Unfortunately, due to unforeseen reasons, the giving of money was prevented from happening.]

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<u>'Art' Work (2011-12)</u>

(Performance, computer & webcam)

'Art' Work was presented in Bergen, Norway during the whole of a two-day seminar entitled 'The Invisible Seminar'. The work revolved around a monitoring of the sound pressure (decibel-level) in a large space. Below a specific pressure level for a determined period of time caused the room to be streamed live via webcam onto the internet. Above a specified pressure level for a determined period of time resulted in me presenting a new 'artist statement' and new piece of work.
